Canada Soccer is looking for a student intern to join its Marketing Department. This student internship position is primarily responsible for supporting and implementing the Canada Soccer Active Start Soccer Fest program.

The student intern position will report to the Marketing Manager and will support a number of projects within the Department with the emphasis on program coordination and operations support.

This is a four month internship position (May to August) with approximately 35 hours per week. Of note, some work will be completed remotely.

As Canada Soccer's longstanding grassroots program, Active Start Soccer Fests enhance community soccer club programming through the delivery of valuable financial, promotional, and technical materials. Reaching close to 150 clubs and 100,000 youth players annually, Active Soccer Fests provide an opportunity for players from coast to coast to fall in love with the beautiful game through a developmental and fun-filled event.

#### Responsibilities:

- Logistical coordination of Canada Soccer Active Start Soccer Fests
- Liaise with community soccer clubs, ensuring that host clubs understand and follow festival requirements
- Pack and ship festival kits as well as managing program inventory
- Develop regular program summary reports
- Support Canada Soccer's Marketing and Communications activities as required

#### Pre-Requisite Skills:

- Strong project managements skills with the demonstrated ability to manage multiple tasks and meet deadlines
- Strong interpersonal skills with the ability to work in a team environment
- Ability to work independently with limited oversight
- Strong communication skill - written and oral (French considered an asset)
