Job Description:

Working under the guidance of the club Technical Director and Academy Director(s) The lead Academy Sports Scientist will be responsible for managing the current success and future direction of the Sports Science Department, players, staff and coaches. This is an integral program under the mandate of the "Foothills Way" club curriculum which requires an individual exuding passion, purpose and personality with a strong desire to facilitate player development within our long term vision as a club under then guiding principles of the LTPD model.

Roles & Responsibilities:

The successful candidate will lead a multi functional Sports Science team and the management of our Sports Science Program, whilst looking at ways to improve the delivery and operation of the program:

- Managing and leading the club Sports Science Team
- Manage staff schedules and on field delivery of all sessions
- Deliver on field delivery of the High Performance Players
- Provide all fitness testing and data to clubs coaching staff
- Complete quarterly PDPs (Player Development Plan)
- Host Sports Science clinics for players/coaches and parents
- Game day duties - pre game and post game routines
- Provide nutritional support to all Academy players
- Management/Administration - word/excel/powerpoint
- Business Function - budgeting/finance/accounting



The successful candidate will possess the following qualifications/attributes:

- MSc Strength and Conditioning (preferred)
- BSc Hons in Sport Science
- Previous experience in working in a football specific program (preferred)
- Preference will be given to candidates with a background with a recognized professional organization
