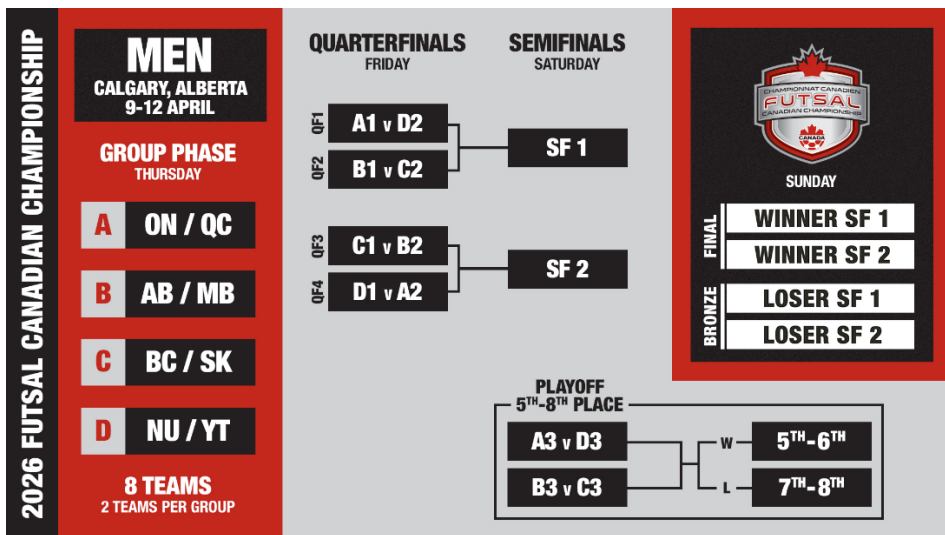

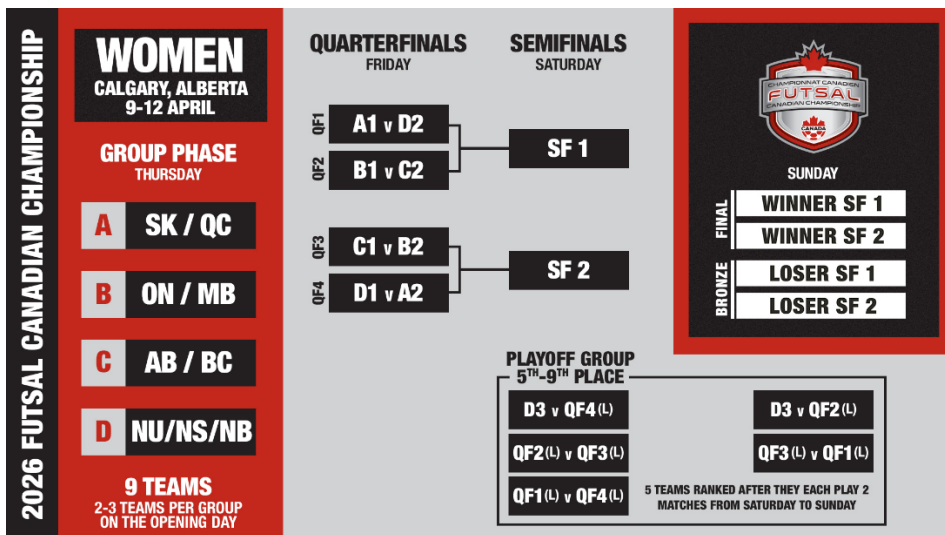
Your division's competition page will include the Schedule and Results (with a "Download XL" button) as well as the list of Participating Clubs (with links to each Club Profile page).

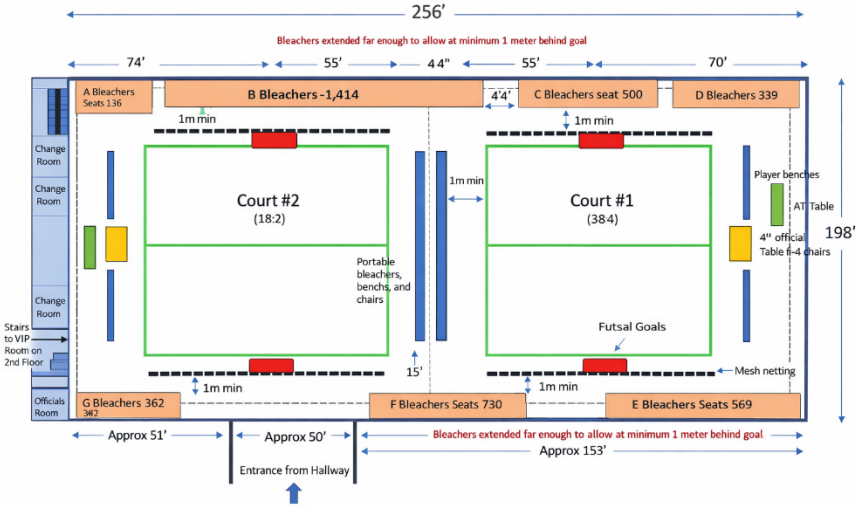
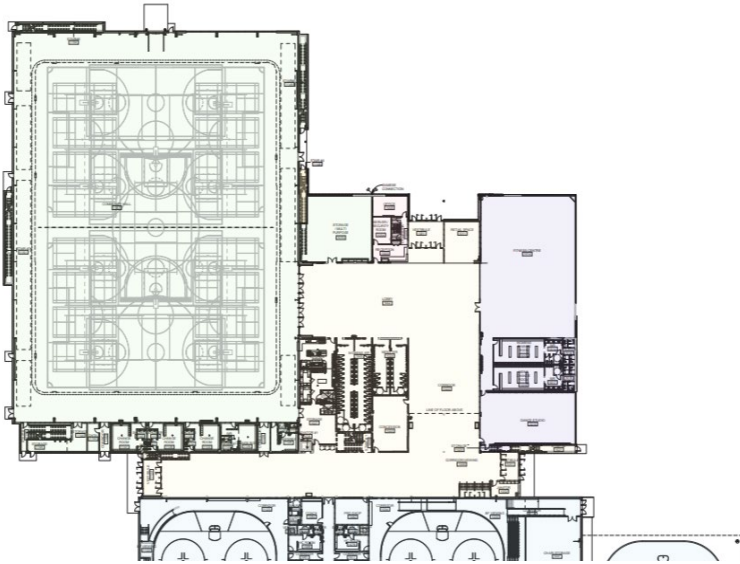

Dressing Rooms

The Seven Chiefs Sportsplex has four dressing rooms available for pre- and post-match use. A daily schedule will be posted to indicate arrival and departure times for each dressing room.

Towels and laundry services are not available at the venue. **On Sunday teams will shower in the Fitness Centre, there are lockers for your use. Locks are not provided.** The space will also be in use by patrons of the Fitness Centre.

It is important to note that **alcoholic beverages are NOT permitted** at the Seven Chiefs Sportsplex.

Athletic Therapy / First Aid

Alberta Athletic Therapists Association (AATA) will supply athletic therapists. Teams must bring their own tape. Athletic therapists will be available one hour prior to the start of each match as well as up to 30 minutes after the final whistle.

Technical / Spectator Areas

Only accredited staff and players are permitted in the technical area. Please refer to the facility map to view specific areas for spectators.

It is important that Participating Clubs, their players and team staff respect the courts and facilities accordingly. Clubs are expected to keep their benches clean and tidy after each match or training session.

TRANSPORTATION OPTIONS

Please note that there will be ongoing road construction on Deerfoot Trail South from Glenmore Trail to south of Anderson Road. Driving speed limits and traffic patterns may be interrupted until construction is completed in 2027.

511 Alberta provides up to the minute traffic and transit information for Alberta.

There is ample parking on site at the venue both in the area in front of the main entrance and along the west side of the Fieldhouse. There will be a youth hockey tournament occurring 8 to 11 April in the two arenas.

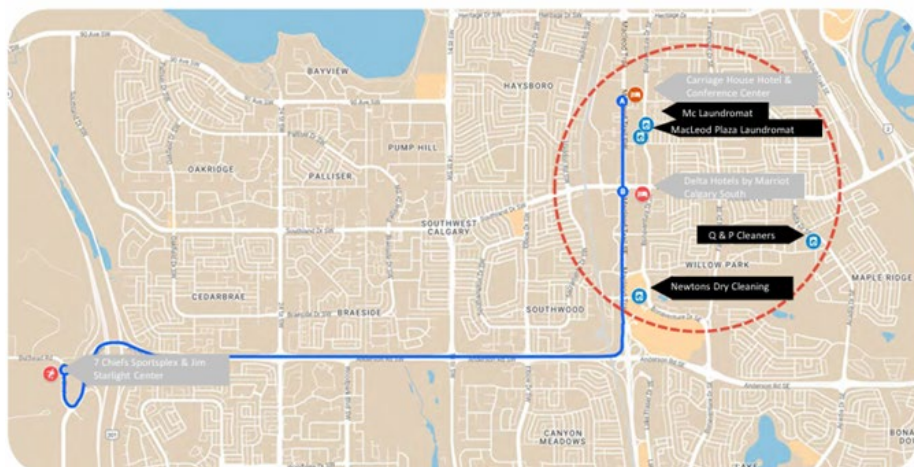

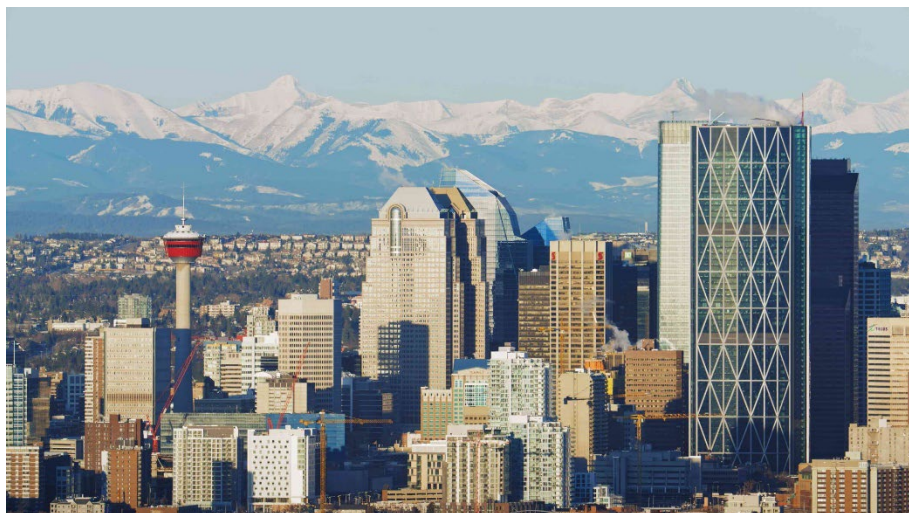

COMPETITION MEETINGS

To help prepare for Canada Soccer's Futsal Canadian Championship, the following virtual and in-person meetings have been planned.

(Virtual) Pre-Arrival Meeting for Participating Clubs

Canada Soccer will coordinate a virtual (Zoom) pre-arrival meeting with all the Participating Clubs in March. Club Participation in one of these two meetings is mandatory.

Option 1 – Friday 11 March at 13.00 ET / 10.00 PT

Option 2 – Thursday 2 April at 19.00 ET / 16.00 PT

The Canada Soccer Match Commissioner and General Coordinator will chair the Pre-Competition Meeting. The PTSO Representative along with a staff or coach from each club must attend the meeting. All clubs must bring one example of each of their player and goalkeeper shirts and socks to this meeting (which means all colour variations for both outfield players and goalkeepers).

Clubs that have players who need to wear a cast or brace must have that equipment checked by the Supervisor of Officials (clubs must RSVP with Canada Soccer if they are bringing additional equipment that needs to be approved by the Supervisor of Officials).

TEAM PRACTICE OPPORTUNITIES

An [online signup form](#) is available for teams to select a pre-competition practice time. Please note that there is only one hour of time available per team. Players will not have access to the dressing rooms during these times. There are washrooms outside the main entrance to the fieldhouse. Teams must bring their own warm-up and practice equipment.

OPENING CEREMONY

The Local Organising Committee will welcome Participating Clubs through a short Opening Ceremony on Thursday 9 April at 19.00 local time (before the last match of the opening day). The ceremony will be held on Seven Chiefs Sportsplex (court #2).

CANADA SOCCER AWARDS

Following the Canadian Finals on 12 April, Canada Soccer will hold one ceremony to present awards and medals for both divisions. The presentation includes the Most Valuable Player award, referee medals, player medals, and the Winners' Trophy.

FIFA+ BROADCAST

Canada Soccer's 2026 Futsal Canadian Championship will be broadcast live in April on FIFA+, the global football streaming platform. This marks the second year in a row that FIFA+ will showcase the Futsal Canadian Championship including the men's and women's Canadian Finals to be played on Sunday 12 April.

This year's competition will feature a record 10 provinces and territories represented across the men's and women's divisions. For the first time ever, the Futsal Canadian Championship will introduce Quarter-Finals and Semi-Finals in both divisions. The enhanced format ensures a full four-day competition with meaningful matches for all participating teams.

At the elite club level, Canada Soccer supports domestic futsal through the annual Futsal Canadian Championship for men and women. The Men's Futsal Canadian Championship was launched in 2015, with the Women's Futsal Canadian Championship introduced in 2023, reflecting the continued growth of the sport nationwide. This past year, Canada qualified for the first edition of the FIFA Futsal Women's World Cup™.

COMPETITION LOGO & BRAND GUIDELINES

Canada Soccer's Provincial/Territorial Soccer Organisations as well as all Clubs and Leagues must follow the brand guidelines to feature the competition logo (either on its own or as a logo lock up next to your league or club logo). **Any and all use of the logo should be approved by Canada Soccer.**
